



### **COVID-19 Code of Conduct**

Golden Eagle Golf Club's highest responsibility is the health and safety of our guests and employees. We are following the direction from Health Authorities and adjusting our operations to reflect best practices within the golf industry.

### **Golfer Expectations**

#### **Before your round:**

If you are feeling ill or have been in contact with anyone who is ill, please do not visit the golf course

Pre-payment is mandatory. Online booking is available 24/7. No Cash Sales

No "walk-ons" welcome. Only players with a confirmed tee time should visit the course

Arrive on the property a maximum of 20 minutes before teeing off unless you are visiting the restaurant prior to your tee time

Masks must be worn when indoors until you are seated at a table

Golfers to practice social distancing at all times (6 feet separation from guests not in your party/bubble)

No loitering/tailgating in parking lot before or after golf. By-law officers will be called immediately

Check-in at the restaurant bar no more than 20 minutes prior to your tee time to check-in and arrange for your power cart (but don't be late!)

No outside alcohol permitted. We have numerous F&B outlets safely selling custom labeled beverages

#### **Power Carts / Rentals:**

Power Carts are available and are to be purchased in advance online or over the phone. Quantities are limited and we will provide carts on a "first pay, first serve" basis

Shared Power Carts (double occupancy) are available to golfers who assume the risk associated with maintaining close proximity with someone in their safety bubble as per order of the Provincial Health Officer.

Single Rider Power Carts are available and can be arranged and paid for by phone (604-460-1111 x1)

Golfers are responsible for removing garbage and recycling from golf carts after use

Personal Vehicles are subject to trail fees. Call for information

Rental Clubs are not permitted at this point in time

**During your round:**

1 player on the tee box at a time, other players to remain in marked areas by the tee

No high fiving, shaking hands, etc.

Rakes & ball washers removed from the course

Cups have been elevated with foam inserts & flagsticks are not to be touched

If you witness a group not social distancing, please contact the Golf Shop (604.460.1111 x1)

**Safety measures we have implemented:**

Increased distance between tee times

Additional cleaning and disinfecting by our staff & professional cleaners

Added sanitizing stations

Cart path markings to allow for proper social distancing on tee areas and kiosk check in

Plexiglass barriers installed and PPE offered to staff

Limiting number of staff on site and checking on their health

Dedicated staff washrooms

Adjusted restaurant service and layout meeting mandates put in place by Provincial Health Officer

**Any guests not following the Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the property**
